The department congratulates Yi Wang (PhD student) who is a recipient of the ASHRAE Graduate Grant-in-Aid for his project entitled “Effectiveness of Ultraviolet Germicidal Irradiation Systems in Air Handling Units in Enhancing IAQ and Energy Performance”. His main supervisor is Professor Chandra Sekhar and his co-supervisors are Professor William Bahnfleth (The Pennsylvania State University) and Assoc Prof David Cheong.

Wang is one of 18 students who will receive a grant through the ASHRAE Graduate Student Grant-In-Aid Award Program, which is awarded to full-time graduate students of ASHRAE-related technologies to encourage them to continue their education in preparation for service in the HVAC&R industry.
